## Climate change needs cross departmental decision-making

Pan-European think tank the Stockholm Network supports the findings and the recommendations of the Treasury Committee report on climate change, released today, namely the need for joined-up government. A minister with a small staff could play a coordinating role – similar to that of a US National Security Council Director.

Stockholm Network's Energy Fellow Paul Domjan adds:

“A single problem, like GHG emissions, is best addressed through a single, economy-wide price, whether set through Cap & Trade or a tax, rather than numerous individual sectoral initiatives. A government minister could help to coordinate policy and take us in this direction”.
