

Jeong-Yeon Lee and Edwin Mansfield, 'Intellectual Property Protection and U.S. Foreign Direct Investment', *The Review of Economics and Statistics*, Vol. 78, No. 2, May 1996, pp. 181-86.

Abstract: This study examines the relationship between a country's intellectual property protection laws and foreign direct investment (FDI) from the US. Through an empirical analysis of 100 US firms the study finds that the level of intellectual property protection in a country does influence levels of US FDI.
